SYMATESE SPEAKS OUT IN THE CURRENT DEBATE ON
AESTHETICS MEDICINE IN FRANCE.

We are delighted that the debate on the regulation of aesthetic medicine was raised at the conference held at the National Assembly on February 12. The conference brought together political authorities, the French Medical Council, and numerous representatives of practitioners' associations.

The successful discussions highlighted the need to strengthen the regulatory framework for aesthetic medicine in order to combat illegal practices in the interests of both doctors and patients.

In the case of hyaluronic acid and botulinum toxin injections in particular, it is essential that patients should not be exposed to serious risks caused by non-medical practitioners acting illegally.

These unethical practices greatly undermine patient safety and damage the image of the entire industry. The conference reiterated the importance of regulated, ethical practice based on medical expertise.

France is a major hub for innovation and the development of new technologies and products for aesthetic medicine. SYMATESE is fully committed to this dynamic as a key player in the sector, having spent more than 15 years applying its innovative developments in the therapeutic field to aesthetic indications in order to meet the growing demand from patients seeking well-being.

Our country is subject to a regulatory framework that is more restrictive than those applicable in other European Union member states and other major territories. These imbalances undermine patient confidence in products that nevertheless meet extremely rigorous European safety and performance requirements when used by doctors.
